Theme: "Walk Worthy"

Theme Verse: Eph 4:1 *"As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received."*

September: Walk worthy of the calling you have received through Jesus.

Ephesians 4:1-6

Sept 1-4th - ¹"As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.

Sept 8- 11th - ²Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

Sept 14-18th - ³Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.⁴There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called;

Sept 21-25th - ⁵one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."

October: I can only walk worthy of the Lord through His power and qualification.

Colossians 1:9-14

Sept 28 -Oct 2nd - ⁹"For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives,^[a]

Oct 8-16th - ¹⁰so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God,¹¹ being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience,

Oct 19-23rd - ¹²and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you^[b] to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light.

Oct 26-30 - ¹³For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

November: Meditating on His (God’s) word strengthens/motivates me to live a worthy life.

Psalm 119:9-16

Nov 2-6th –

⁹How can a young person stay on the path of purity?

By living according to your word.

¹⁰I seek you with all my heart;

do not let me stray from your commands.

Nov 9-13th -

¹¹I have hidden your word in my heart
that I might not sin against you.

¹²Praise be to you, LORD;

teach me your decrees.

Nov 16-20th -

¹³With my lips I recount

all the laws that come from your mouth.

¹⁴I rejoice in following your statutes

as one rejoices in great riches.

Nov 23-27th -

¹⁵I meditate on your precepts

and consider your ways.

¹⁶I delight in your decrees;

I will not neglect your word.”

December: We must walk in the light to walk worthy of His calling.

1 John 1:5-10

Nov 30 – Dec 4th – ⁵This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. ⁶If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth.

Dec 7-11th - ⁷But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all ⁸sin.⁸If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

Dec 14 – 18th ⁹If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.”

January: We must choose to walk in obedience to walk worthy of His calling.

Deuteronomy 30:15-20

Jan 4- 8th – ¹⁵See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. ¹⁶For I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in obedience to him, and to keep his commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess.

Jan 11- 15th - ¹⁷But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, ¹⁸I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess.

Jan 18 – 22nd - ¹⁹This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live

Jan 25 – 29th - ²⁰and that you may love the LORD your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. For the LORD is your life, and he will give you many years in the land he swore to give to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.”

February: As He who calls us is holy, so we must also walk in holiness.

1 Peter 1:13-16

Feb 1- 5th – ¹³Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.

Feb 16-19th - ¹⁴As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.

Feb 22-26th - ¹⁵But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; ¹⁶for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”

March: It is in Christ that we can walk blamelessly before God.

Ephesians 1:3-10

March 1-5th – “³Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. ⁴For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

March 8-12th - In love ⁵he^[a] predestined us for adoption to sonship^[b] through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— ⁶to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.

March 15 – 19th - ⁷In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace ⁸that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding,

March 22-26th - ⁹he^[c] made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, ¹⁰to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ.”

April: Walk worthy of God’s calling by clothing yourself in humility.

1 Peter 5:5-10

April 7-16th – “⁵In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because,

“God opposes the proud
but shows favor to the humble.”^[a]

⁶Humble yourselves, therefore, under God’s mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.

April 19 – 23rd - ⁷Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. ⁸Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. ⁹Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings.

April 26 – 30th – ¹⁰And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. ¹¹To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen.”

May: Walk worthy of God’s calling, faithfully and with integrity.

1 Kings 9:3-7

May 3-7th – ³The Lord said to him:

“I have heard the prayer and plea you have made before me; I have consecrated this temple, which you have built, by putting my Name there forever. My eyes and my heart will always be there.

May 10-14th - ⁴“As for you, if you walk before me faithfully with integrity of heart and uprightness, as David your father did, and do all I command and observe my decrees and laws, ⁵I will establish your royal throne over Israel forever, as I promised David your father when I said, ‘You shall never fail to have a successor on the throne of Israel.’

May 17- 21st - ⁶“But if you^[a] or your descendants turn away from me and do not observe the commands and decrees I have given you^[b] and go off to serve other gods and worship them,

May 25- 28th - ⁷ then I will cut off Israel from the land I have given them and will reject this temple I have consecrated for my Name. Israel will then become a byword and an object of ridicule among all peoples.”
